Culture & Heritage Museums has new executive director

ROCK HILL, S.C. – The Culture & Heritage Commission met on Mon. Dec. 16 and voted to appoint Richard Campbell as the new executive director of Culture & Heritage Museums. Campbell stepped into the role of acting executive director on Aug. 6, 2020 at the commission's request.

Chair of Culture & Heritage Commission, Penny Sheppard says "We have been thrilled with the work Richard has done since stepping in as acting executive director and could not be more thrilled that he was willing to take on the position." Campbell had been the museums' director of business, marketing and operations since 2011.

Culture & Heritage Museums continues to move forward with major projects underway for each site: preservation and restoration for Historic Brattonsville's 30 historic structures is ongoing, window restoration at the McCelvey Center is in full swing, repairs are proceeding for Main Street Children's Museum after extensive water damage in Oct. 2018, and a new major permanent exhibit at Museum of York County is slated for opening in mid-2020.
